Thanks for all your hard work on this difficult speech to get it as right as possible. Here are a few comments and questions:

We need to work in reference and quotes from POTUS Nobel speech near the top. I haven't read it yet so not sure what's most appropriate. Since the speech alluded to some of the same ground, should we be explicit in asserting that this speech further clarifies/expands/explains what this Admin means by human rights?

The points about us not being perfect and the existence of evil in the POTUS speech should be woven in more here too. For example, in discussion on p.7 about Japanese internment, etc.

In the section about supporting individual defenders, should mention that we did that thru State Dept ceremony honoring brave women and applaud others like Vital Voices and RFK memorial who do same. Tell story about how I was asked to mention the name of a Guatemala activist in my speech to the parliament there because the attention might literally save her life.
