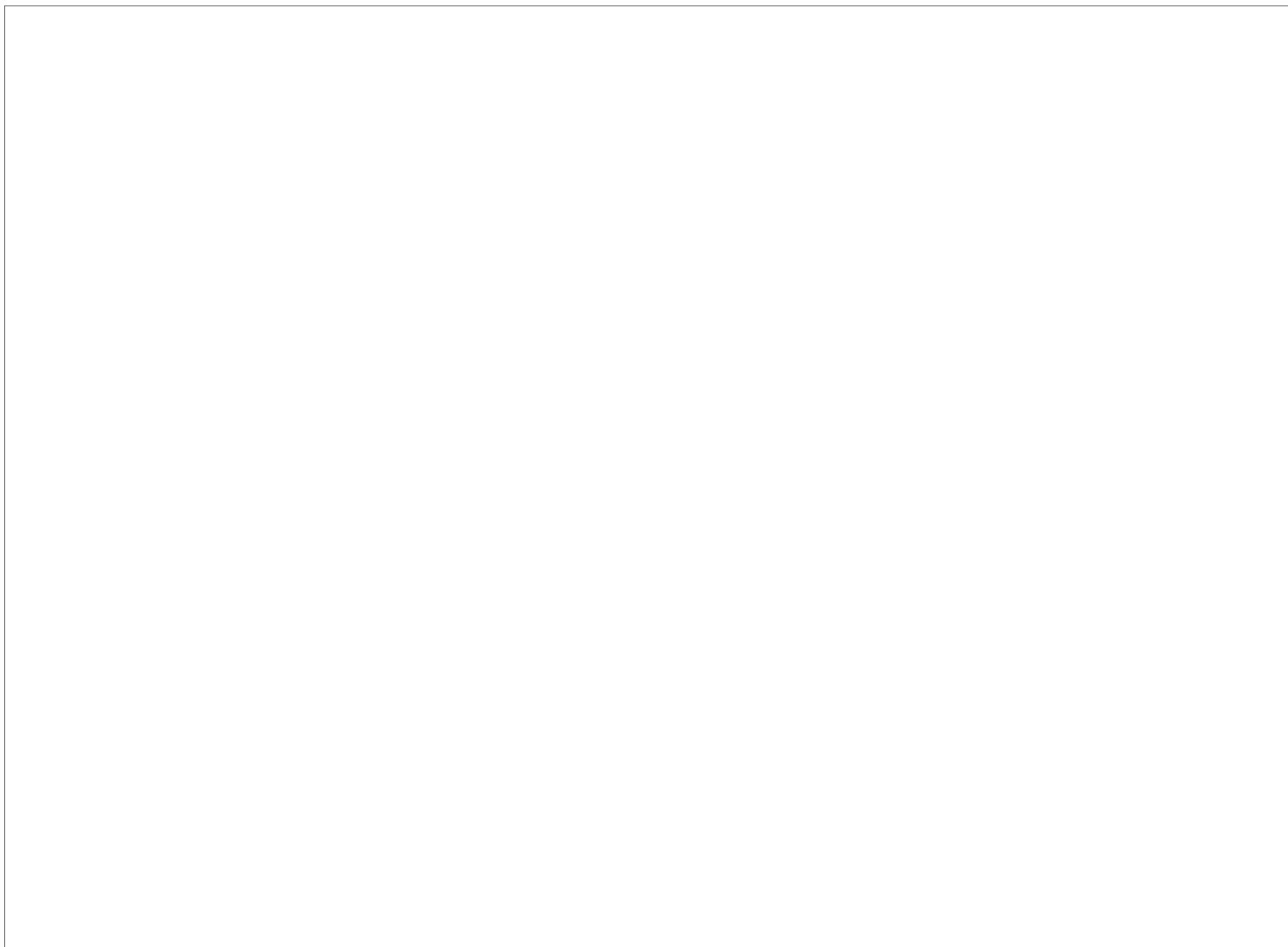

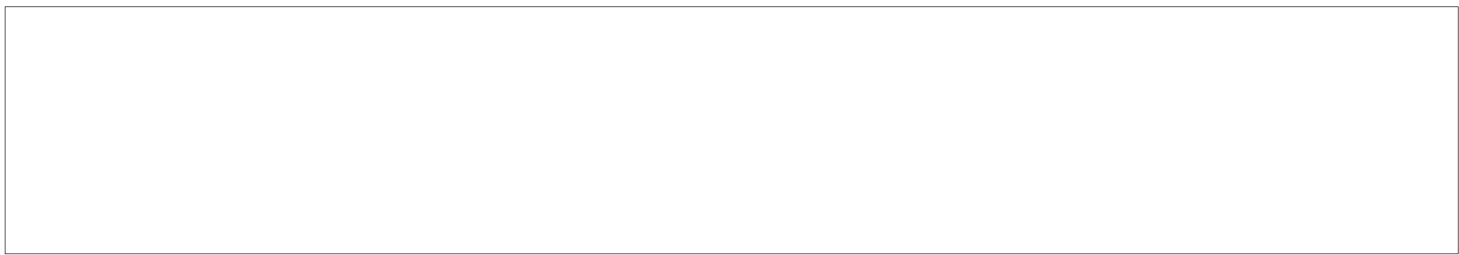

Attached is the revised Afghanistan script. At RCH's request, it is clearly linked to the slides and papers that we submitted. [redacted] everyone was receptive to the civilian strategy outlined.

We understand that the current plan is for the Secretary to participate via VTC or phone and the script has her leading throughout, then passing to RCH and/or Amb. Eikenberry.

One new development: [redacted] Discussion of the ANSF will now precede discussion of reintegration/reconciliation. We have kept the "ANSF Hurdles Slide Package" separate (sent on the high side), but noted in the script where that can be referenced. We anticipate Amb. Eikenberry will also be ready to discuss his concerns regarding the proposed ANSF build-up.
