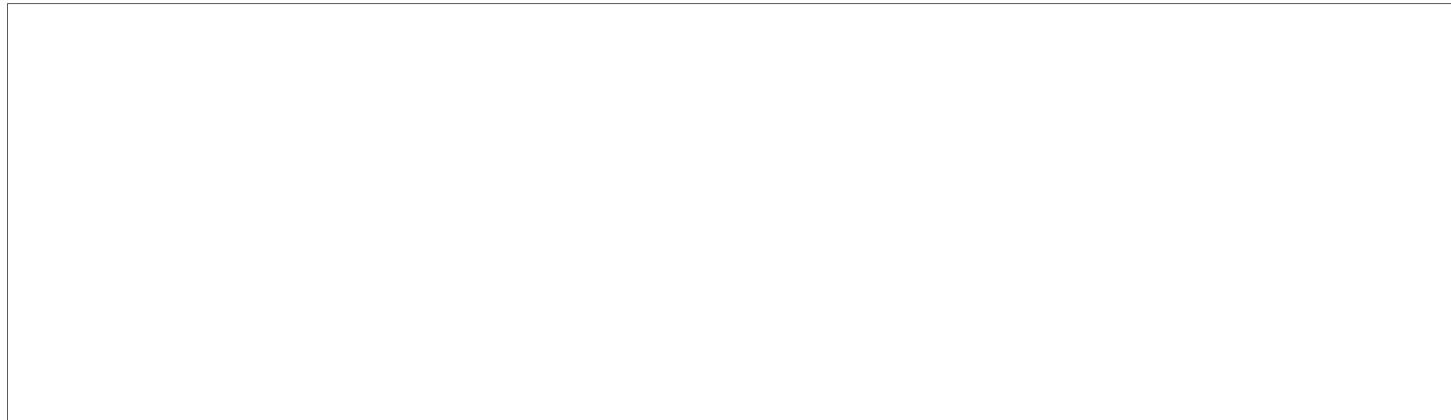

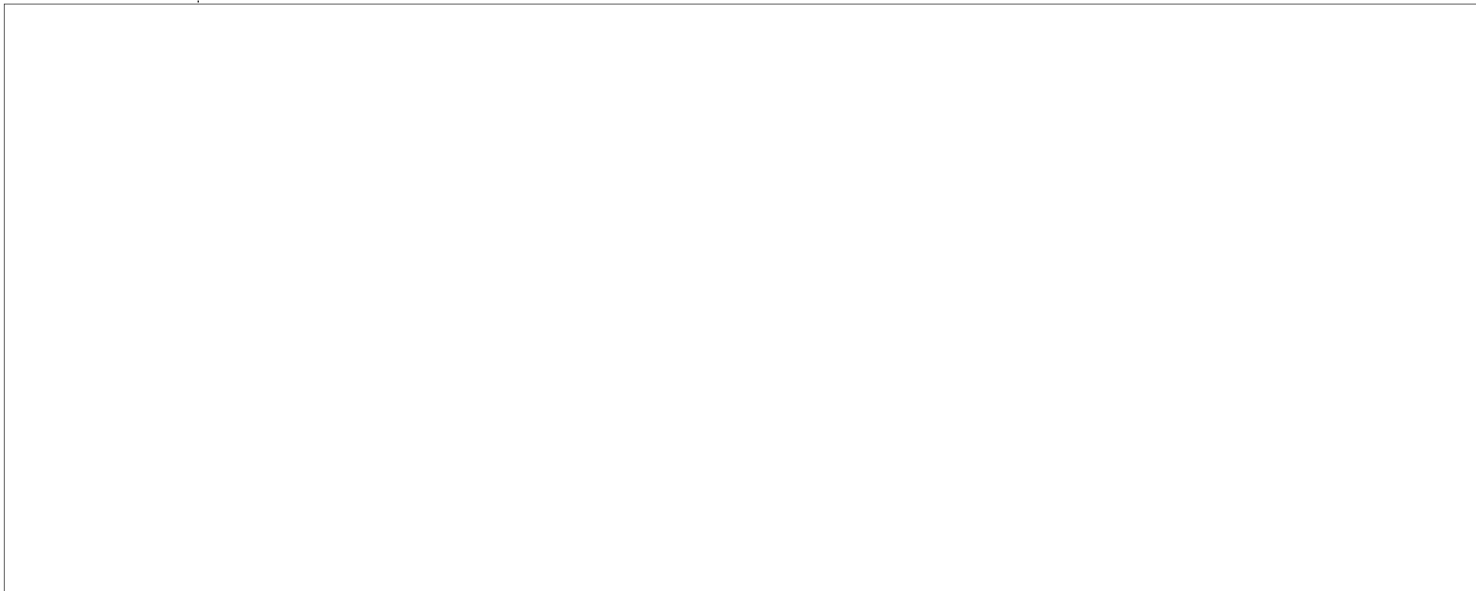

Cheryl,

It was great to speak with you yesterday. With regard to the proposed Philippines compact, I promised to lay out options for the Board meeting and signing.

Some background: At least five Board members (a simple majority) must approve a compact. All past compacts received unanimous support with the exception of Namibia, when one private sector member abstained. (As you know, the Board has 9 members, 5 public sector members, 4 private sector members; one of the private sector seats is currently vacant, leaving the Board at 8 active members.)
