GEN Renuart confirmed that he wants to make this happen. The need was validated at this morning's conference call. An NGO would like its support.


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Our operations center here at NORTHCOM recommended that SOUTHCOM make the request for the aircraft because they are the supported Command. I passed the information to my counterpart at SOUTHCOM and AMB Trivelli said this morning during the conference call that they would pass information to the SOUTHCOM operations center to get the request in.

 in Mexico is the point of contact at the Embassy Mexico City to get the specifications regarding size, weight, location etc for the field kitchen. We will need this information to determine exactly what type of aircraft will be required. It will probably be a C-17 but there may be other options.

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
