A few updates over night on the Wikileaks issue:

- We know that the NYT has only reviewed DOD docs, but [redacted] believes that some of the docs are also State Dept cables. B5

- DOD will review the docs, and [redacted] State Ops will be on call to help with the reviewing.

- We're still expecting the three print stories (NYT, Der Spiegel, Guardian) to go on line Sun night, after the docs are posted. We understand AP has the story of the leak (but not the docs) and may write sooner.

[redacted] I will share.

- Mullen is with Kayani, and will notify him. Amb Patterson will notify the civilians.

- Amb Eikenberry has notified Karzai, as well as other senior Afghan officials.

- Others will be notified today - including India, UK, Germany, and NATO.

- Hill notification will still take place Sun morning.
