He will continue to serve on the board of directors of Highstar Capital, the infrastructure advisory firm. Berman, a Rochester native, is a key fundraiser for Mitt Romney, and was Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Policy under President George H. W. Bush. His wife, Lea Berman, was White House social secretary under President George W. Bush.
