Dear Melanne,

Hope this message finds you well.

I am trying to follow your work and every time I run into information that involves you as a speaker or presenter, I know that strong advocacy for the benefit of women is coming for the future.

I am starting a foundation, with a objective to advocate policies on health, environment and human rights. Women in the region have serious obstacles to access health care and services, and are suffering from a lack of information. Many preventable diseases are taking its toll because of the lack of information and facilities, especially regarding breast cancer and cervical cancer. Also, laws on health care do not require for preventive services such as mammography, pap smear and other preventive services. I am planning to work on different level, not excluding other target groups but starting with women.

Today, media have announce the visit of Secretary Hillary Clinton in the region, including Kosovo. Is there any chance to meet with her during short visit in Prishtina? I know she is coming to assist the dialogue between Prishtina and Belgrade, but she would be even more helpful if she meets me and other women.

New early elections are coming in few months and she would bust our confidence and would support better participation of women and better election result.

I am afraid that our government officials are going to meet alone and/or be very selective who can meet her because is going to have impact on the election.

I am not with any political party but would be wonderful and extremely helpful for the support of woman's agenda Is any chance that you will be coming with Secretary Clinton?
