Our main amplifying event today was an on-the-record roundtable for Ambassador Eikenberry with 12 major Afghan media outlets. AMB Eikenberry gave some remarks highlighting key parts of the speech for Afghanistan, and took several questions. We will see lots of coverage of this tomorrow.
