The Cambodians then offered another option. PM Hun Sen would meet with Amb Rodley on Monday about the draft Law on Associations and NGOs. Post had previously sought meetings with PM Hun Sen, but the Cambodians had demurred. This would be Rodleys first meeting with PM on this topic.
