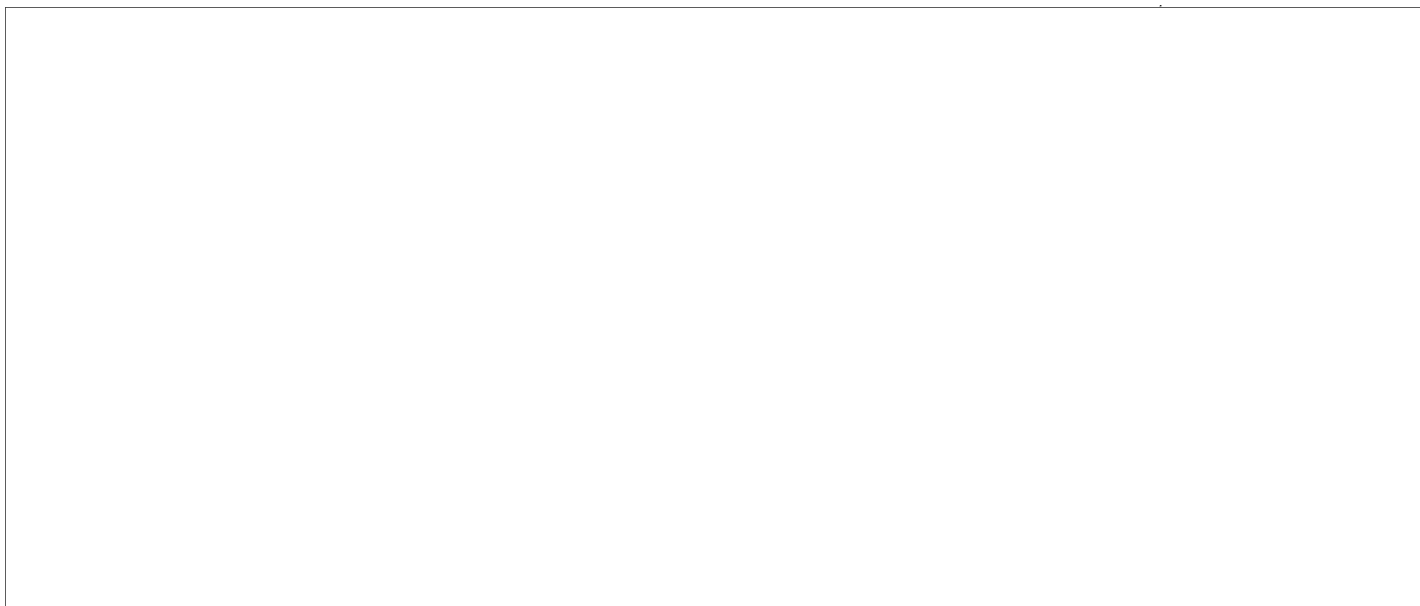
Madam Secretary,

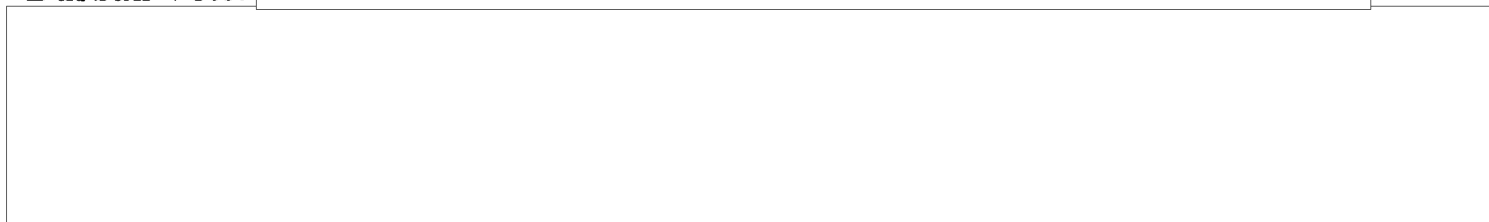
