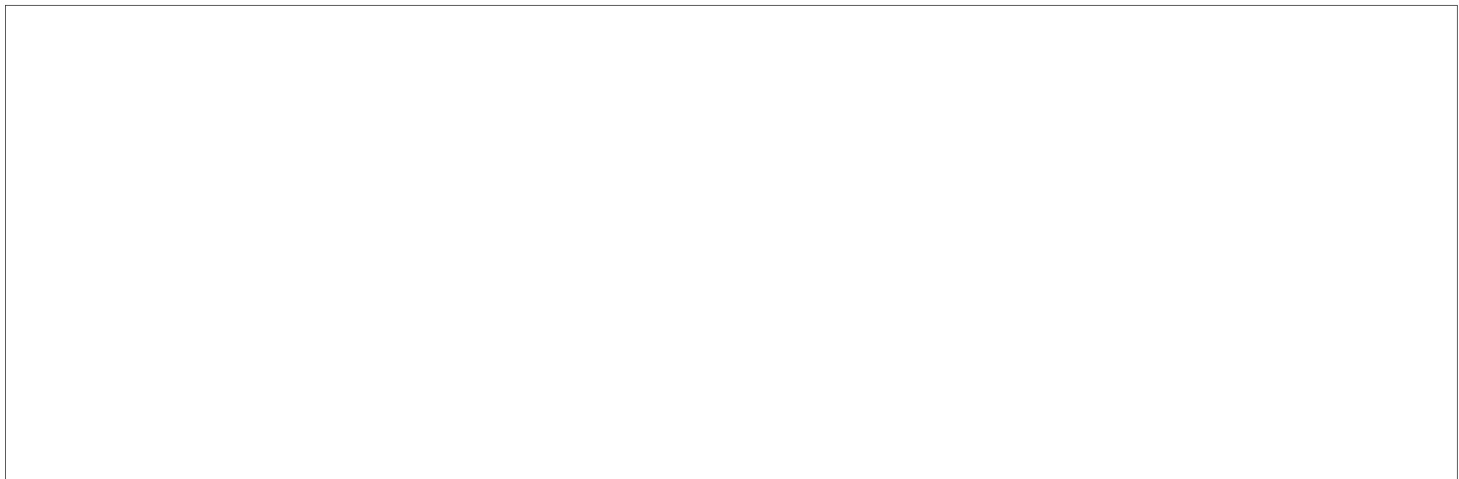

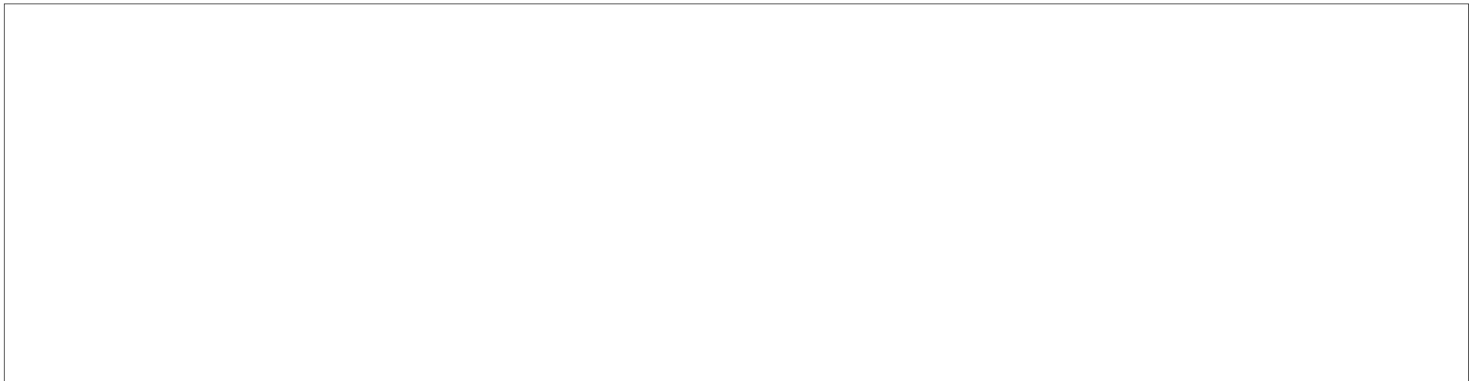

Here is a bootleg of the WHA/EEB note:

Honduras was the second country to receive an MCC compact, worth \$205 million over 5 years; it was the first country to conclude its compact, in September 2010. The MCC compact was extremely successful – improvement of 350 miles of roadways and increased agricultural activity, with more 7,000 farmers moving to the production of to higher-value crops. The compact also promoted passage of a secured transactions law that is a regional model for expanding access to credit.
