If someone in the Department believes the Secretary should consider someone for the award, the FAM directs sending a memo to the Executive Secretary to bring to the Secretary's attention. Since I have been in this job, I've received two such recommendations:

[redacted] After consultation, we determined that the Secretary's Distinguished Honor Award (which requires review by the Department's awards committee, which provided approval this week) would be more appropriate. That was based on my sense that the Distinguished Service Award is more appropriate as a person wraps up his/her career in the federal government, and that a Distinguished Honor Award who makes a significant contribution to US foreign policy interests over a more limited scope.
