Hillary:

This is a quick update on the high-level meeting of the Open Government Partnership (OGP) we are hosting at State on Tuesday July 12. I've been working closely with the White House in anticipation of your announcement with Brazilian Foreign Minister Patriota of this multilateral initiative. We will have 55+ countries represented at the Tuesday meeting, including 20+ minister-level officials. We will also be joined by 60+ leading civil society representatives from around the world. The day of meetings will include presentations by more than 15 governments on their own domestic efforts in combating corruption, enhancing transparency, and increasing civic participation in 21<sup>st</sup> century governance. It will also focus on the use of technology for pursuing open government. The full agenda is in your briefing papers.

Thank you again for agreeing to open and close this important event. I am grateful to U/S Kennedy for his help in pulling this off with such short notice. It will lay the foundation for the follow-on OGP meeting on the sidelines of this year's UN General Assembly - we're close to confirming the President's participation.

Countries have expressed a surprisingly high level of enthusiasm for this new initiative. After the July 12 meeting, I want to find a way to house "open government" at State as a compliment to ongoing domestic work; it should grow its legs here as part of the work we are already doing on government transparency and engaging civil society. I will develop a proposal for your consideration.
