While he didn't explicitly call for Ch VII sanctions, he did say that the Council had to "insist on the full implementation of its prior resolutions and make clear that there will be consequences for non-compliance." That gave us and our allies some string to play with. We still have a long, hard road ahead and not much confidence in getting anything great out of the UNSC, but we got a better launch than we anticipated today.
