Per prior email, we are back to drawing board. Here is the last brainstorming list, with a few new additions. Let me know your thoughts.

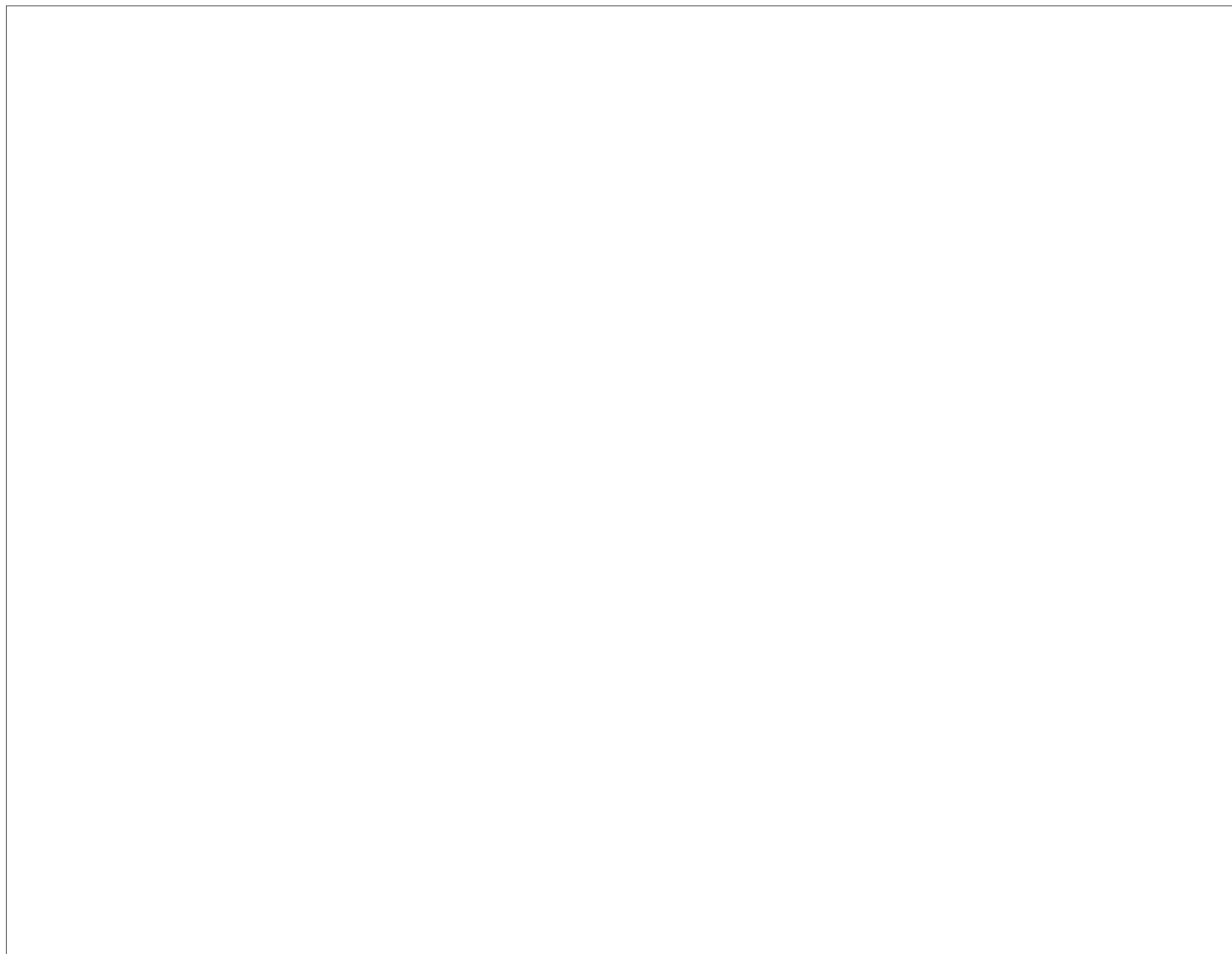
