Eleven killed in Syrian army attack in Damascus area

AMMAN (Reuters) - At least 11 people were killed in fierce fighting in the Damascus suburb of al-Tel when Syrian forces mounted an armored attack to attempt to regain the area from rebels, opposition activists said.
