A small group of soldiers have apparently taken over the Ministry of Communication, but there does not appear any to be any effort to go attack the president's headquarters or home or to take over the ministry of defense. Asmara is calm. We do not/not have any dependents at post and our numbers are low. Number of US citizens is (very) small. A warden message is being sent out and our team has met. Will keep you up to date. Johnnie

(SBU) Embassy Asmara reports the acting information minister has reportedly been arrested. State run television and radio have stopped broadcasting.

(SBU) All chief of mission personnel are safe and accounted for.

(SBU) Diplomatic Security Command Center reports it is believed the Eritrean government is in the process of suppressing a possible coup. However, there are no obvious signs of a coup and no reports of violence or gunfire.
