The current forecast for Andrews is for the winds to be "out of limits" starting the "Sunday evening" and lasting until early Wednesday.

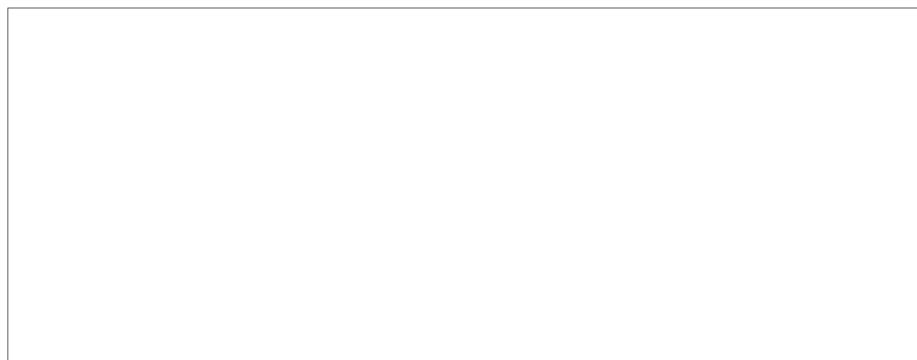
The current hurricane track forecast has New York being effected for the same approximate time.
